#### **Thinner**

Water

#### **Dilution**

The paint is ready to use after proper stirring. No thinning is required.

#### **Conditions during application**

The temperature of the substrate should be minimum 10 °C and at least 3 °C above the dew point of the air, measured in the vicinity of the substrate. Good ventilation is usually required in confined areas to ensure proper drying.

#### **Drying times**

Drying times are generally related to air circulation, temperature, film thickness and number of coats, and will be affected correspondingly. The figures given in the table are typical with:

- 1. Recommended data given is, for recoating with the same generic type of paint.
- 2. In case of multi-coat application, drying times will be influenced by the number and sequence and by the total thickness of previous coats applied.
- 3. The surface should be dry and free from any contamination prior to application of the subsequent coat.

#### **Surface preparation**

The substrate must be sound, clean, dry and free from dust, oil, grease, laitance etc. All traces of form release agents/curing agents must be removed. A light sanding with suitable abrasive material is recommended before application. Any resulting dust/loose particles must be removed.
