This is a two component chemically curing polyurethane coating. It has hydrophobic properties and long lasting anti-icing performance. This prevents ice formation and reduces ice adhesion in freezing conditions. It has excellent impact and abrasion resistance and elasticity. To be used as topcoat in atmospheric environments. Developed for use on glass fiber reinforced epoxy and polyester.

Protective: Specially designed for protection of wind turbine rotor blades as part of the wind turbine anti-icing solution.
