Product description

Type

A high-build acrylic texture compound incorporating the multi-layer coating system to decorate and camouflage uneven walls on interior and exterior walls.

Recommended use

For interior and exterior application.

Substrate

On concrete and masonry surfaces.

Application methods

Spray application: Gravity Feed Hopper Gun or other suitable equipment. Consult Jotun for additional information, as required.

Conditions during application

The temperature of the substrate should be minimum 10 °C and at least 3 °C above the dew point of the air, measured in the vicinity of the substrate. Good ventilation is usually required in confined areas to ensure proper drying.

Spreading rate per coat

Film thickness and spreading rate are varies depending on texture finish/pattern. General guideline is 0.9 - 1.5 kg per square meter.

Drying times

Drying times are generally related to air circulation, temperature, film thickness and number of coats, and will be affected correspondingly. The figures given in the table are typical with:

Good ventilation (Outdoor exposure or free circulation of air)

Typical film thickness

One coat on top of inert substrate

The given data must be considered as guidelines only. The actual drying time and time before recoating may be shorter or longer, depending on the ambient temperature, film thickness, ventilation, humidity, underlying paint system, requirement for early handling and mechanical strength etc.

- 1. Recommended data given is, for recoating with the same generic type of paint.
- 2. In case of multi-coat application, drying times will be influenced by the number and sequence and by the total thickness of previous coats applied.
- 3. The surface should be dry and free from any contamination prior to application of the subsequent coat.

Directions for use

Surface preparation

The substrate must be sound, clean, dry and free from dust, oil, grease, laitance etc. All traces of foam release agents must be removed. A light sanding with suitable abrasive material is recommended before application. Any resulting dust/loose particles must be removed.
