## **Product description**

This is a three component elastomeric silicone tie coat. It provides excellent adhesion for Jotun FRC Topcoat. Can be applied directly onto the following primers:

Jotacote Universal N10 Jotacote HF002 Jotaprime 500 Alu / Alu RT Jotaprime 510 Penguard Universal

Recommended for under water hull in newbuilding and drydocking. Specially designed as a tie coat for Jotun FRC Topcoats, ensuring a relatively long over coating interval giving flexibility in production.

#### Thinner/Cleaning solvent

Do not add thinner.

For maximum overcoating intervals, refer to the Application Guide (AG) for this product.

After finished application the substrate temperature must be kept at minimum 50 °F (10 °C) for at least 2 hours. Lowest substrate temperature during the drying/curing period is 41 °F (5 °C).

Drying and curing times are determined under controlled temperatures and relative humidity below 85 %, and above 30 %, and at average of the DFT range for the product.

Note: The cured product will reveal some tackiness.

Surface (touch) dry: The state of drying when slight pressure with a finger does not leave an imprint or reveal tackiness.

Dry to over coat, minimum: The recommended shortest time before the next coat can be applied.

## Storage
