Type

Strong cleaning agent based on alkalis and other biological raw material degraders.



Features and benefits

Use **DEMIDEKK Terrassfix** for long durability before treatment with **DEMIDEKK Terrasslasyr**. The detergent provides the best basis for new treatment, removes old stain, cleans and makes the wood lighter. With **DEMIDEKK Terrassfix**, it becomes easy to change the terrace color.

Recommended use

The product cleans, removes previously stained/oiled treatment and brightens impregnated wood.

Remark: Wear gloves and goggles. Do not spill on window glass, painted substrates, plastic details or untreated aluminium. Avoid spillage in places other than the surfaces to be cleaned. Corrosive hazard!

NOTE! Not suitable for use on exotic hardwoods.

Application data

Corrosive liquid. Keep out of the reach of children. Do not swallow. Irritant. Wear suitable gloves. Use eye protection (e.g. protective goggles). Do not spill on window glass, painted substrates, plastic details or untreated aluminium. Corrosive hazard!

It dissolves tarry products like roofing paper, shingle etc. Avoid spraying the product directly onto plants. Any spills may be rinsed off with clean water.

Application equipment / methods

Brush or roller.

Cleaning of painting tools

Water and **JOTUN Penselrens** or water and a suitable cleaning agent.

Thinner

Use unthinned.

Consumption

Recommended 8–10 m²/liter.

Directions for use

1)	Moisten the substrate lightly with cold water. Avoid ponds with water.
2)	Pour DEMIDEKK Terrassfix into a suitable tray and apply by brush/roller in a limited work area. Leave on for 15–20 minutes.
3)	Keep the floor wet by applying more DEMIDEKK Terrassfix with brush mounted on an extender shaft. Massage DEMIDEKK Terrassfix into the substrate with a brush repeatedly. Keep the area moist using DEMIDEKK Terrassfix during the active time. Let the product, in combination with light scrubbing with a brush, do the cleaning job.
4)	Scrub the floor lightly with a terrace scrub with extension shaft. Scrub the tree's longitudinal direction to counteract wood fiber defuzzing.
5)	Rinse well with plenty of water. Use garden hose - not high pressure washer since this will splinter the surface of the timber. The terrace floor can be treated after drying with med DEMIDEKK Terrasslasyr . Please note! Incorrect working method or weathered decking can give defuzzing frayed wood surface. If required, it is recommended to lightly sand before treatment with DEMIDEKK Terrasslasyr or JOTUN Treolje .

Storage

Frost free storage because the container may burst during freezing. In storage and in transport keep the container upright.

Disposal of waste

Liquid cleaning agent must not be emptied into drains or watercourses. It must be delivered to an approved local environmental protection station.
