Brush: Recommended for stripe coating and small areas, care must be taken to achieve the

specified dry film thickness.

Roller: May be used. However when using roller application care must be taken to apply sufficient

material in order to achieve the specified dry film thickness.

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#### Thinner/Cleaning solvent

Thinner: Jotun Thinner No. 7 / Jotun Thinner No. 10 Jotun Thinner No. 68

Jotun Thinner No 68 can be used for longer open time and less dry spray during application in warm conditions. Recommended maximum addition is 10% (on volume) in ready mixed paint.

Jotun Thinner No. 63 can be used to reduce the drying time if required. Recommended maximum addition is 5% (on volume) in ready mixed paint.

Note that the pot life will be reduced when adding the thinner.

Dry to over coat, minimum: The recommended shortest time before the next coat can be applied.

Dried/cured for service: Minimum time before the coating can be permanently exposed to the intended environment/medium.
