Product description

This is a three component biocidal foul release coating based on advanced Elastotain® technology. It is a high solids product with a diffusion controlled biocide release under challenging conditions. A smooth, ultra low friction surface reduces hull deterioration and improves hydrodynamic performance. Recommended as a topcoat for immersed conditions over approved tiecoats only.

A complete application procedure covering dry docking with Jotun Foul Release Coatings (FRC) is available, ref. TSS-TI-084.

Recommended for underwater hull in newbuilding and drydocking. Specially designed as a premium solution giving flexibility in vessel trade and activity. It has high gloss and excellent color stability providing long term aesthetics appearance. This product is suitable for extended docking intervals up to 90 months as a part of a complete coating system.

Dried/cured for immersion: Minimum time before the coating can be permanently immersed in sea water.
