### **Application methods**

Spray:	Use air spray or airless spray.
Brush:	Recommended for stripe coating and small areas, care must be taken to achieve the specified dry film thickness.
Roller:	Use a suitable roller. However when using roller application care must be taken to apply sufficient material in order to achieve the specified dry film thickness.

Walk-on-dry: Minimum time before the coating can tolerate normal foot traffic without permanent marks, imprints or other physical damage.

Dry to over coat, minimum: The recommended shortest time before the next coat can be applied.

### Storage
